



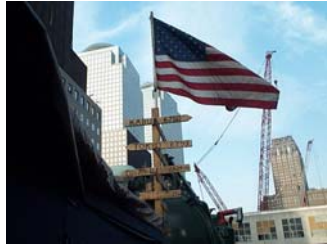
# Disaster Recovery Services

On Oct 1st, 2001 just 21 days after the World Trade Center disaster, MIT was called upon to perform installation services of GPS devices for all the debris removal equipment working on the recovery effort. MIT took on the challenge and by doing so, MIT became the Prime GPS Installation Provider for the WTC Recovery Effort. MIT crews worked 12 hour shifts, 7 days per week inside Ground Zero to complete the task of installing 300+ GPS units into debris removal trucks while they worked. Since then, MIT has been recognized as a turn key provider for various types of disaster recovery services.
